

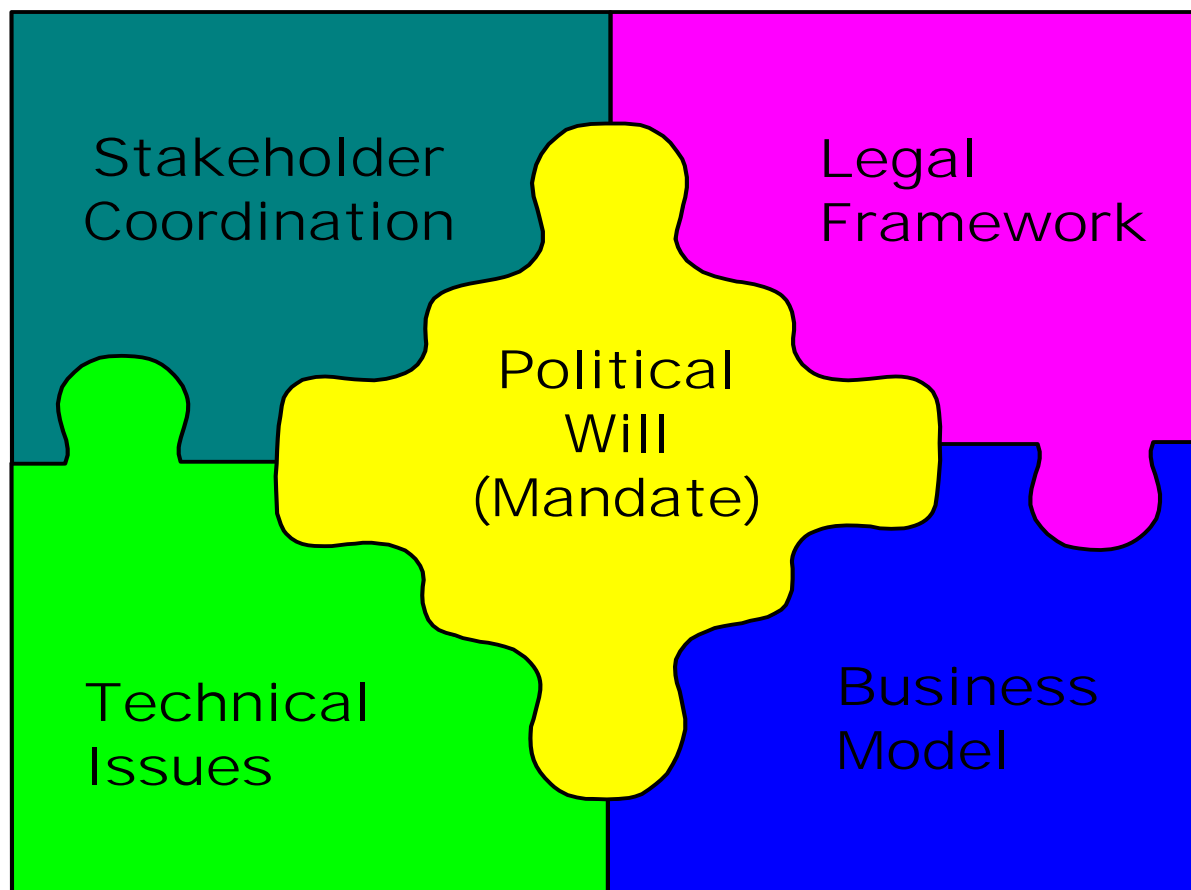

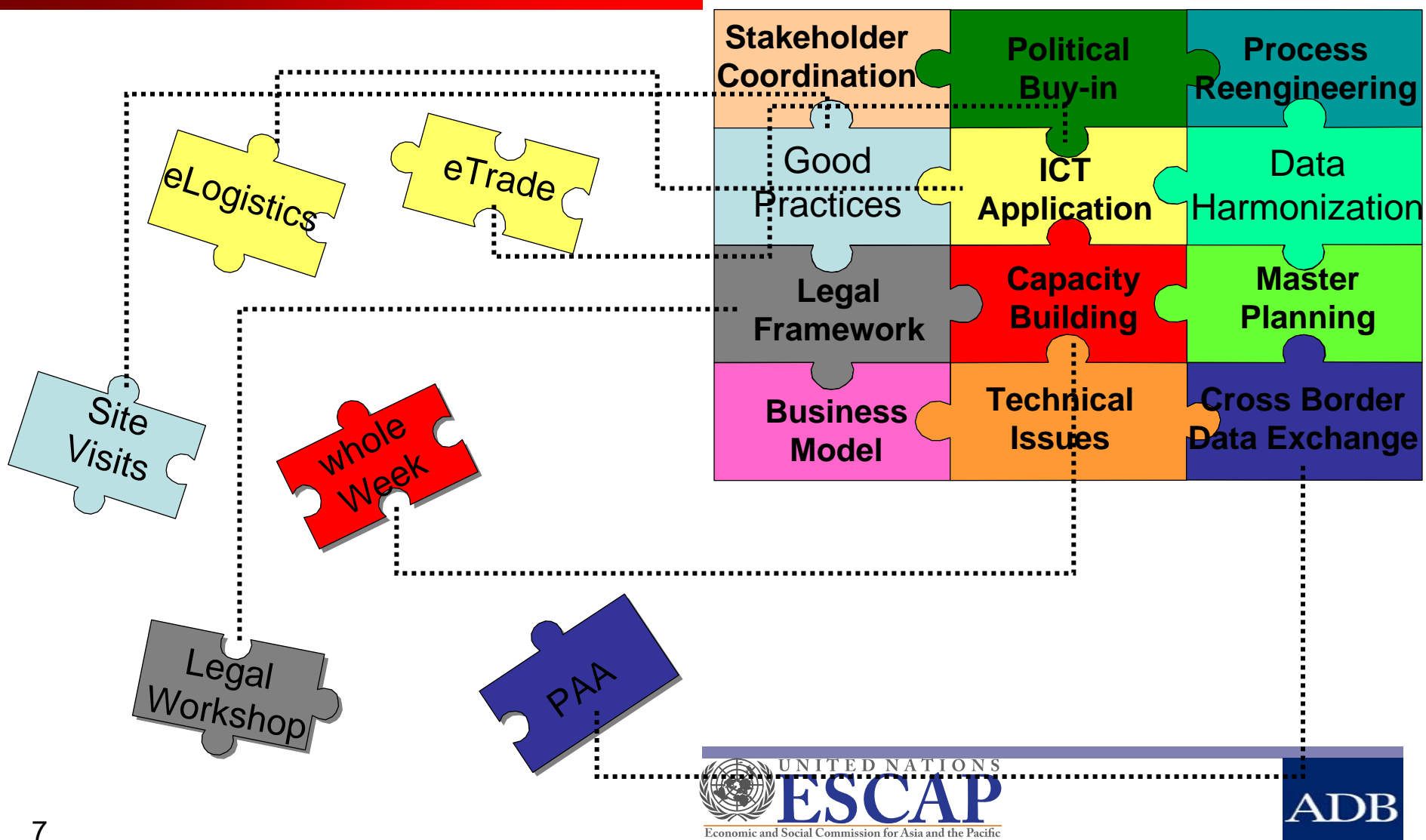

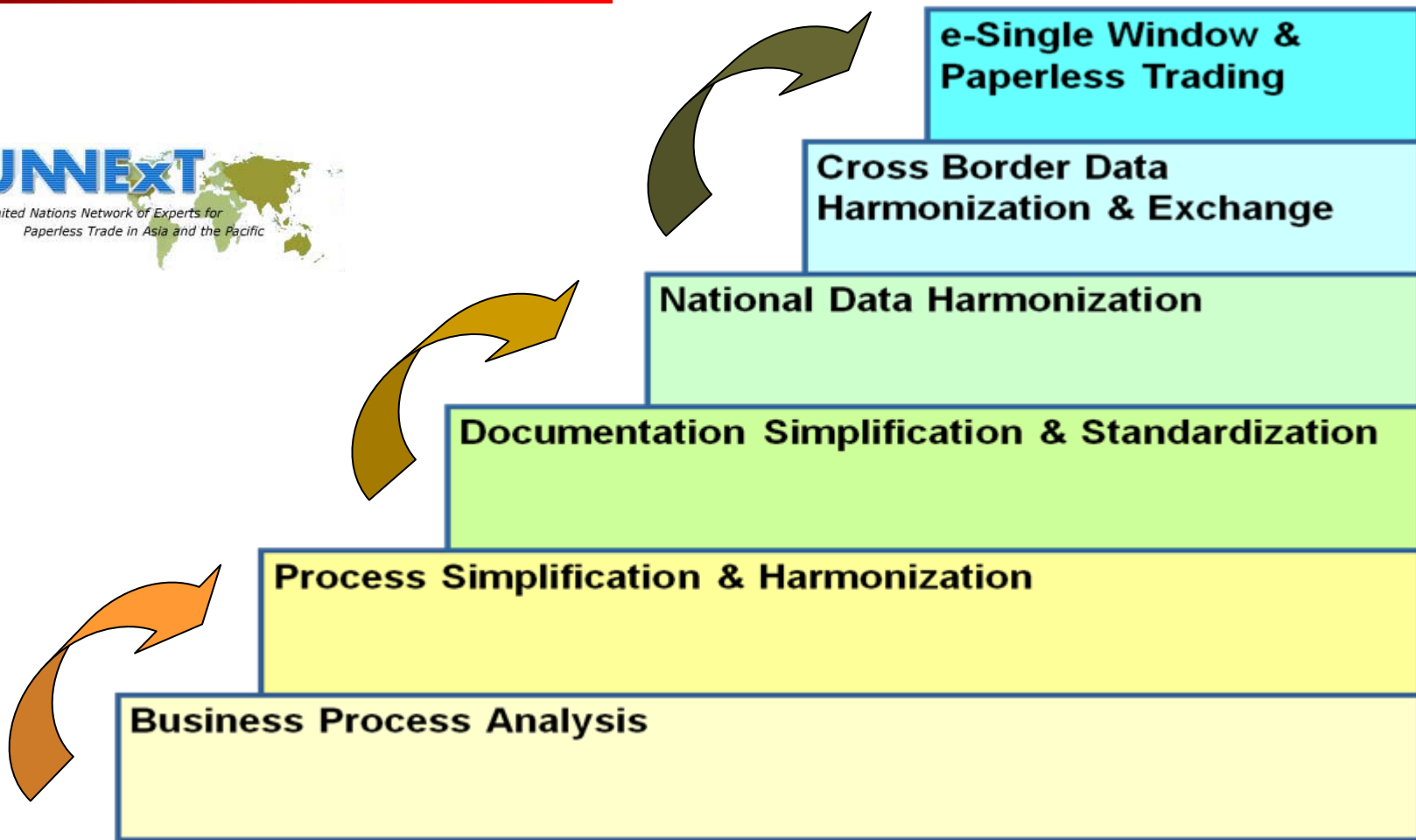
Core Components of Single Window Implementation
